EXAMPLE OF SHIELDING FILE

The shielding histories do not all contain the same information. The data available in the shielding histories varies according to the date when the original interview was conducted, the location of the survivor (Hiroshima or Nagasaki), and the particular situation or configuration existing for the survivor ATB. All shielding histories examined have the "Radiation Shielding Summary" form which contains the information required for the T57D system. The house penetration distance was used to calculate the attenuation factor for survivors in Japanese houses in the T57D system.

BLAST: His house collapsed toward the west, perhaps because the blast blew from the south to the west and he was pinned under it.

SOUND: None.

RAIN: About the time (0900 hours) he escaped to the Temma River, large drops of rain kept on falling for about an hour and a half and he was drenched to the skin.

On that morning, he was lying on his back in an eight-mat room. His wife, (M.F. No. 292-000), was stretching a mosquito net in the same room and his eldest daughter, (M.F. No. 292-001), was combing her hair in a three-mat room. Just at that moment, he was exposed to the A-bombing. In a moment, when he was exposed, a pale fire-ball (about 2 feet in diameter) like an electric spark was dropped before his eyes and simultaneously, the house was lifted from the ground as though being thrown up in the sky, perhaps because the blast blew in from the south to the west and it was struck to the west. The house was completely destroyed. The minute he was pinned, it became pitch dark and he was unable to see anything for a short while.

When he looked around after it became bright, many blocks of wood were lying heavily on him. But he was able to extricate himself while struggling desperately. When he freed himself, a fire had already started in his neighboring houses. After he rescued his wife, by removing the blocks of wood of the collapsed house, he went to rescue his eldest daughter, . As he found daughter's arms sticking out of the remains of the collapsed house, he could rescue her rather easily.

By that time, the flames approached closer to them and the three of them escaped to the north of the Temma Primary School. As the Temma Primary School building was already swallowed by the flames, they jumped into the Temma River at high tide. From about that time, large drops of rain began to fall heavily. However, the fire did not die out. Sparks of fire shot up and came down violently that it was impossible for them to bear it.

Leaving only his wife and holding on to a drifting wood with his daughter, the two headed to the north and swam as far as the foot of Misasa Bridge where they took a rest. After a short rest, he went down south along the river bank while worrying about his wife. He met his wife in the water under the Hirose Bridge where his wife was waiting for him. The three of them headed toward the north along the river.


They reached their designated place of evacuation at 59-13 Yamate-cho, around 11:30 hours via Yokogawa Bridge and Ippon Bridge. On the way, a large number of people suffering from wounds were seen in the rivers and they were avoiding the heat. However, they were dying rapidly one after another.

Since then, they have been residing at 59-13 Yamate-cho. Thus, their designated place of evacuation has turned out to be their present address.

Furthermore, from about 11 August 1945, he commuted to 500 Nishi Temma-cho from Yamate-cho for 10 days in order to clear the fire devastated sites.




