The authors will modify the RP to clarify this point.◆ The statement “Data to be provided by RERF” in the RP indicates total kerma dose, but such data actually will not be used in the diagnosis concerned. It is therefore recommended that the following statement be deleted: “The following data will be used to diagnose dyslipidemia or Sjögren’s syndrome.”
