The RP also needs to refer to “types of information” and “approaches to obtain research funds.” ◆The two documents, “Consent form for donation of blood” and “Explanatory note regarding written consent,” should be revised in a manner to keep a consistency. ◆The “Application for Ethical Review,” “Consent form for donation of blood,” “Explanatory note regarding written consent,” and “Request for discontinuation of use of blood samples for the study” should be revised in accordance with provisions of the revised Ethics Guidelines for Human Genome/Gene Analysis Research.
