2	Clinical Studies	"Ophthalmological study of A-bomb survivors using a new ophthalmic camera"	Approved	<p>◆ The following revisions should be made to the Informed Consent for Ophthalmological Study (hereinafter referred to as the "consent form"):</p> <p>1) In the description of the objectives and contents of the study, "Please be assured" should be deleted from "Please be assured because responsible researchers of this ...we will refer you to an ophthalmologic clinic immediately." This is because the relevant phrase is unnecessary.</p> <p>2) In the description of the protection of personal information, "only for research purposes" should be deleted from "... the information obtained from this study will be used only for research purposes with..." This is because the relevant phrase is unnecessary.</p> <p>3) In the description of the collaborative institutes, "Hiroshima Univ., Nagasaki Univ." should be deleted because these universities are not involved in this study.</p> <p>◆ With regard to compensation for health problems caused by the conduct of this study, it is necessary to refer to the ethical guidelines and confirm contents of the insurance that RERF purchased. When there is a need for explanation of compensation, the RP and consent form should refer to the relevant issue.</p>
