Outline": "1. Name of project" should be revised in conformity with the revised title of the RP. With regard to "2) In entrusting all or part of the handling of genetic information, matters that will be stipulated in a contract and supervision of the relevant entrustee" in "10. Safeguarding of genetic information," "Samples (will be provided to outside organizations)" should be replaced with "Materials (information)."
