Kodama <i>et al.</i>)	Approved	<p>(1) The application for revisions to human subjects RP will be revised, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Additional explanations will be made regarding the means for storage and disposal of samples/information, matters to be reported to the chief executive of the research implementing entity and how to make the report, and status of research-related conflicts of interest of the research implementing entity. <p>(2) The information disclosure form (Form 1-5-1) will be revised, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Regarding the “purpose and method of using samples/information” and the “samples/information items to be used or provided,” the wording as indicated by IRB will be made readable for the general public; ➤ The description in the “scope of use” will be revised to clarify that the researcher to whom data are provided belongs to another organization.
